

## **Our Charges Explained – INTEGRATED MEDIATION**

### **(Fees are per party)**

Meetings may include time spent with parties or their professionals separately as well as together and time estimates for meetings include these periods.

### **MIAM**

*A Mediation Information and Assessment Meeting will follow the process set out by the Family Mediation Council and is aimed at helping the mediator assess suitability of the case for mediation and to help the client understand how mediation works and their other options.*

If we have not already seen the party's individually for a MIAM we will need to do this first.

Time estimate: 45 - 60 minutes

**The charge for the MIAM is £195 plus VAT per person, per session and can take place via Zoom or in person at our office.**

### **Planning meeting with all proposed participants (including advisers):**

*The planning meeting is to ensure that all participants understand the principles of Integrated Mediation, in particular outlining rules of confidentiality and the role that each participant will take.*

Time estimate: 30 - 40 mins

**The charge for a Planning Meeting (Zoom) is £165 plus VAT per person = total £198 per person**

NB: Charges for 3rd Parties' attending to be agreed and settled directly between client and 3<sup>rd</sup> party.

### **Sessions:**

*Integrated mediation sessions are scheduled for either a half day or full day. Meetings will be a combination of group meetings with all participants, separate meetings with clients and their advisers and meetings just with the experts, as appropriate. Separate rooms will be*

*available for each participant to enable them to consult with their advisers privately if they wish.*

**½ day (3 hours\*): (Zoom or in office) £550 plus VAT = £660 per party**

**Full day (6 hours\*): (Zoom or in office) £1000 plus VAT = £1200 per party**

\*For half day appointments timings will allow for break midway of 30 minutes, and full day appointments will allow for a lunch break of 1 hour midway – these times are not charged for. Please note that lunch is not provided.
